Why in news ?

- According to the recently released World Bank's 'Logistics Performance Index Report (2023): Connecting to Competitiveness 2023', India is ranked 38th out of 139 countries.
- It is noteworthy that India has improved its ranking by 6 points. According to the list of year 2018, India was ranked 44th.



Other important points

- In this index, Singapore is at first place, followed by Finland at second place, Denmark at third place, Germany at fourth place, Netherlands at fifth place, Switzerland at sixth place, Austria at seventh place, Belgium at eighth place, Canada at ninth place and Hong Kong at tenth place.
- At the same time, names of important countries like America, Russia and the UK are not included in it.
